

Come and See

John 1:35-39

35 Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;
36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!
37 And the two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus.
38 Then Jesus turned, and saw them following, and saith unto them, **What seek ye?** They said unto him, Rabbi, (which is to say, being interpreted, Master,) where dwellest thou?
39 He saith unto them, **Come and see.** They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day: for it was about the tenth hour.

Jesus asked, “What seek ye?” They answered, “Master where dwellest thou?”
Jesus answered, “**Come and see.**”

John 1:45-46

45 Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.
46 And Nathanael said unto him, Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see.

Here Philip told Nathanael, they had found the Messiah. Nathanael asked, “Can any good thing come out of Nazareth?” Philip answered, “**Come and see.**”

Today people; Jesus is calling out, saying, “**Come** and see. **Come** dwell with me; I in you and you in me! **Come** and see that the Lord is good. **Come** and see that my burden is light. **Come** and see my yoke is easy. **Come** and see; that I will give you rest for your soul.”

John 1:51

51 And he saith unto him, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, Hereafter ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man.**

Jesus answered, “**Ye shall see.**” We the Church are calling out to the Lost – **Come and See** the glorious salvation of the Lord.

In John chapter 4,
